# TECH TALK with John Dodson

Our show is just around the corner. Many of you will be showing your car. Some of you have worked so hard to get your car ready. This months tech talk will be on showing your car and judging. When the group of men come walking around your car. What do they look for. First your car is divided into four sections. 1. engine, 2 chassis, 3 interior, 4 exterior. Small shows will usually use a 100 point system. While a very large show may use a 1000 point system. In most cases there will be 4 or 5 judges. Each will be assigned one area to judge. Detail is the key. How much real work has gone into the car. These are usually not professional judges. They are just regular guys that may have a car in the show. Before they come around, have a friend look your car over and give you his honest opinion. Let him point out what may be noticed. If he points out to much. Ask if you can judge his car. You must be there when the car is judged. Last year, I got a First place trophy for

my car. I honestly believe the other car was better, but when the judges came around. The other cars owner was no where to be found. Put your car in the show. Even if you think it may not whin a trophy. This ant the mopar nationals. Its a club event for all to enjoy. Ive enclosed a copy of a judging form. it was used at a recent car show. Cleanliness goes a long way. Especially when your in hot competition.

A personnel note: There will be allot of people at our car show. Many from out of town. Please turn on our southern kindness. Make them fill welcome. If a man pulls up in a Daytona, let him know your glad to have him at our show. But give the same kindness to the man that pulls up with a truck load of junky looking parts. Its gonna be a great show.
