

When I was a kid, the most appreciated gifts I ever gave to my parents were things I made myself. No admittedly, they were usually amateurish attempts at making something really great, but it was the thought that counted. . . Well, this year, at Christmas, I had the opportunity to try my hand at creating something to give to my lovely wife as a gift. . . One that would help her forget the pain of losing the Holy Roller II (temporarily I must hasten to say) to competition for most of this coming season.

What I did was purchase a 1967 Dodge Coronet Deluxe that was in pretty solid condition, and with the help of several friends and the utilization of a trove of spare parts that were gathered for other projects, many long since abandoned, embarked upon a two week adventure into the realm of race/street car creation.

Engine wise, a 1972 440 was secured from Jerry Taylor. Boy was this sucker sad. . . All rusted and filled with water. I happened to have a set of +.030 K.B. Hypereutectic pistons from one abandoned project just sitting gathering dust, so piston selection was simple. I had numerous sets of bearings and sure enough one was the correct size for the mildly turned crank. I did have the assembly balanced though. I had to purchase rings and went moly units as this was to be a "durable" dual purpose ride. I used a used windage tray that was gathering dust in the corner of the shop (that's a story in itself). So the bottom end was complete save for the camshaft.

Whenever you build a car, take care in the selection of parts so as the avoid mismatching things or overbuilding. . . Since I wanted the car to run in the Heavy class (8.50 - 9.99), my stuff would have to be tamed down significantly. The only cam I had that was suitable was a Lunati with some strange numbers - slightly warmer than a GTX cam, but nothing great. To keep the car in the class I decided to kill torque for the get go. . . The cam was set in at 116 degrees on a recommended 112. . . . To further choke the combination down, I used 1974 3769902 heads (so bad they were produced only half a year). To kill torque more yet, I used Hooker Competition headers, and Robert Vachunek installed 2½ inch aluminized exhausts WITHOUT a crossover. For carburetion we installed a new competition series 950 vacuum secondary Holley (unreal carburetor).

With the driveline OK it was time to paint the car back to a color similar to the non-descript it was originally. Enter Robert Vachunek's next door neighbor Keith. . . For a most reasonable sum he painted the '67, and we were ready for Christmas day. . .

Donna was thrilled with the car. The police car rims with pick up truck centers, the B.F. Goodrich Comp T/A radials and nasty sounding exhaust won her over. Wanna know what? She still wants the Holy Roller back, but isn't quite as itchy about it.

With only one outing on the car thus far it has done very well. With a 3.55 gear, 8.5 x 26 slicks (new - green - not working yet), leaving at 2000 R.P.M. (nothing for the converter in the car), letting it shift itself at 4800 R.P.M.'s, weighing nearly 3900 pounds, the beast has ripped off an impressive 8.63 E.T. at 79.68 M.P.H. It will get a touch quicker (like 8.50) as the slicks break in, but I will resist the urge to put decent heads on it, or let Donna shift it manually at 5600 or so. Why defeat the purpose. This car should be a KILLER in the Heavy class at any track.

I've often told you through this forum and TECH TALK when I first initiated it, that PACKAGING IS THE KEY... I was careful about my selections and my procedures and ended up with a car that is currently only .13 seconds from its ultimate goal... Why don't I just take the spare and jack out and nail an 8.50...! Maybe I will... Another well packaged car belongs to Dale McDaniel - I can't wait to see that thing get it on... Hey Dale, wanna borrow some funny looking narrow slicks!
