Also don't forget - Starting at Noon September 22nd, there will be people on sight to start setting up and to "guard" your cars if you bring them early.





Tech Talk

Hello, Mopar Lovers,

My name is Robert S. Vachunek. I have been a member for about three years. Most people recognize me for having the yellow 68 Valiant. I have elected myself to the Tech-Talk portion of the newsletter. Please keep an open mind toward my English.

Ithought I would start with Carburetors. Through the years of working on automobiles, I have found this to be a big problem for a lot of people. One problem is picking the correct carburetor for your car, then installing it on your car correctly. After this has been done you are ready to set your carburetor up, (By the way, it has been my experience that size doesn't make a difference when set up correctly. I have a 950 Baby Block, and the motor loves it!).

One big problem is wrong power valves in the carburetor. One way to check this is to use a vacuum gauge. To do this hook the gauge to a manifold source, then have someone start the car. After the car has reached running temperature, have someone put the car in gear and let it idle and you look and see what the reading is. Then start subtracting from it by 2 in. lbs. For example, my car reads 12.5 lbs. I put a 10.0 power valve in it. (You can do down at little more if needed, but remember if you go big you will get too rich reaction and if you so too small you can get a hesitation.)

Just remember a power valve is just a timer that controls how fast or how slow your gear gets full richness under full throttle.

I hope this will help you in the set up and understanding of a Holley Carburetor. And remember there is no car like a MOPAR!

Rev. Mopar's Grease Pit

In the past two installments I have waxed eloquent with regard to packaging when building a car. I cannot stress this enough for those of you doing projects of a "modified" nature. Rare is the occasion that you can purchase only one part that will make a good change in your engine. Usually several parts are necessary to complete a package. In this month's GREASE PIT I would like to reveal how, even in individual components, packaging remains the key.

Three months ago I told you about our four door car and mentioned that the carburetor was an article unto itself. . . So here goes. . . The product in question is HOLLEY'S new Pro Series carburetor, which comes in both a mechanical and vacuum secondary version. This

ricular product is one that was developed as a complete PACKAGE. . . The premise behind the series is to offer a non-dominator carburetor that offers dynamic performance throughout the RPM band and is easily turned to work with many applications. Let's look at this product.

In reality this is a new, old product. . . By utilizing "racer science" (years of trial and error), the folks at Holley have assembled a carburetor that functions on the principle of increased air velocity. The carburetor flows between 920 and 950 CFM but has components, discounting float bowls, from carburetors no larger than 850 CFM. . . How can this be? Elegantly simple. . . Use the naturally occurring demands of the engine, gravity, and tailored (read smoothed) air flow, all to increase velocity and BINGO, instant results.

To better understand how this works, look at a toilet! Sounds funny, but it's the best analogy I can draw from. When you activate the flush valve, the bowl empties very rapidly, forcing the waste product out. A toilet is also shaped like a tapered funnel thereby using gravity, (in this case water) velocity, and drainpipe vacuum demand (those funny pipes that come out your roof aren't there for fun you know). The outside air flows through a modified 750 air horn that utilized the two step booster, the air horn is tapered into a larger 850 double pumper throttle plate (see diagram).


The end result is a product that is really well suited for street / strip applications. The idle is smooth, the acceleration at moderate throttle is brisk, and full throttle acceleration has to be felt to be believed. And although these carburetors are somewhat at this time, they are truly a value since they work so well. Further, you will spend at least \$100.00 more money on a Barry Grant carburetor of a similar nature and end up with a product that would be hard pressed to surpass the performance of the new Pro Series carburetor direct form HOLLEY.

I seldom endorse a specific product in my writings, be in my situation, I installed a Pro Series carburetor on our four door bracket / street car and have only set the idle - that's how good this product works. It is a full tenth quicker than the 750 double pumper we had on the car in the beginning, and ours is a vacuum secondary unit. The helpful folks at Holley have made MOPAR carburetor shopping easy, at least as far as I'm concerned. . .

If you have any questions concerning this carburetor, or this article, please feel free to call me. I have to admit, I'm more excited about this product than I have been about any other in a long time. Holley has done for carburetion what John Erb and K.B. have done for pistons, pushed the envelope and developed a cost effective piece that works in spades. . .
