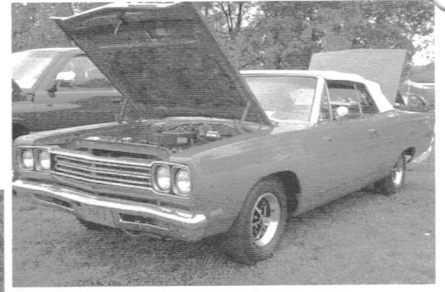
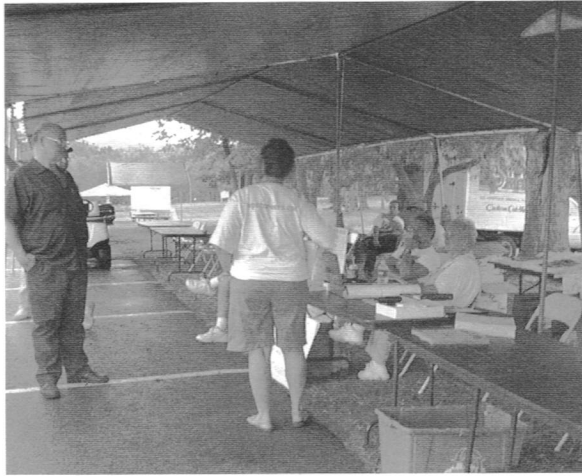
The Hybrid

Hybrid (hy-brid)- something of mixed origin or composition. (see picture)

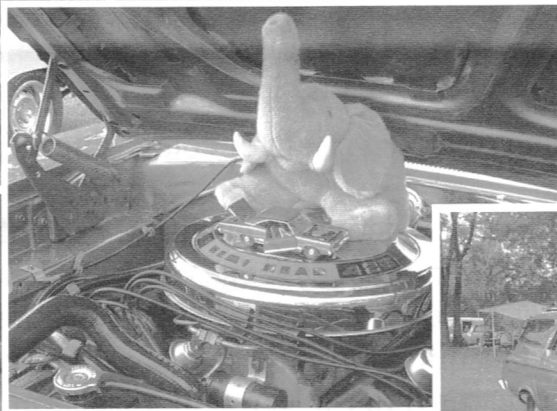
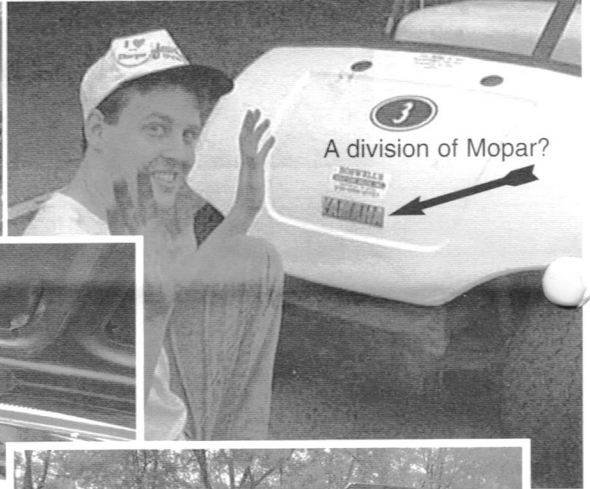

MCMC member Thomas Silcox is the owner of this creation, or at least he was several months ago when he gave me this info. Sorry it's so late. Anyway, this Mitsub...er, uh Dodge pickup is definitely not your everyday, run-of-the-mill, rice burin' D-50. This one has been retrofitted with a 340 mill sporting a tunnel ram intake and 2 four-barrel carburetors. All that torque is transmitted to the rear tires via a quick shifted 727 tranny and a sure grip rear end with 3.23 gears.

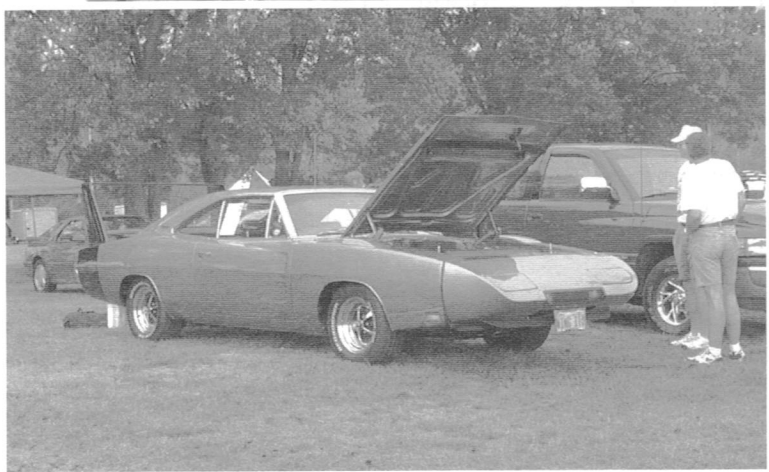

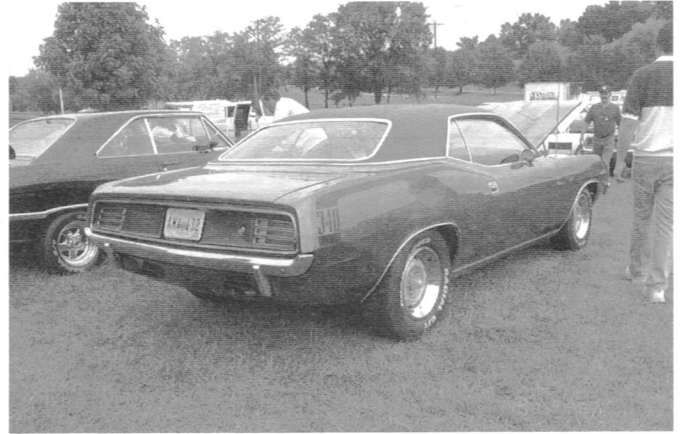

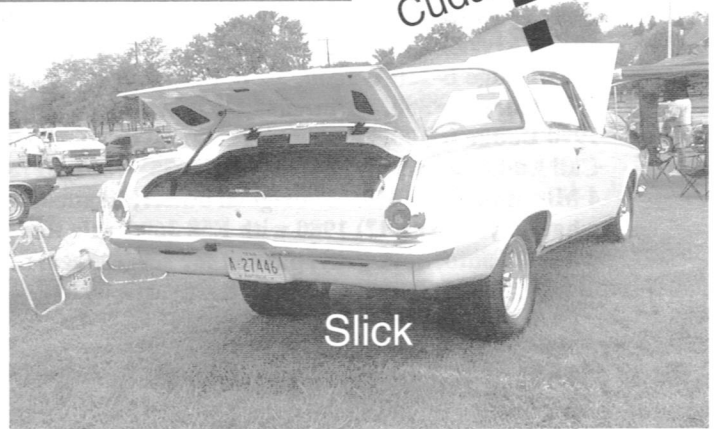
