I have restored a 70 model 1/2 ton and know the cost, and mine is not the quality of restoration as this truck, but I still spent at least double the asking price of \$7000.00, and as you can see this is a turn-key truck, you have nothing to do to the truck to make it road worthy, just get in, drive, and enjoy.
