Follow S. Church Street to the junction of US-41 / US-70S, this is SE Broad Street.

Turn Right onto SE Broad Street and go approximately 0.5 miles. (2nd Traffic Signal)

Turn Left onto Mercury Boulevard / US-70S and continue approximately 0.6 miles.

Turn left, just past the Pizza Hut into the shopping center parking lot.

The cruise-in will be on your left.
