I also want to note the loss of two members of the Mopar racing community. Bobby Hamilton Sr., a local racer who did well and raced and won in the top 3 tiers in NASCAR, died on January 7, after a year long fight with cancer. Hamilton, who was the 2004 Craftsman Truck Series champion, was 49. Cigar-chomping Dick Landy was a pioneer in the Funny Car and Pro Stock ranks of drag racing in the 60's and 70's. Landy represented Dodge and did Drag Racing Clinics at the Dodge dealers to support dealer car sales and organized drag racing. Landy died on January 11 of kidney failure. He was 69.
