## **Directions to Murfreesboro Meeting**

At

Wilson County Bank & Trust SummerFfest 3110 Memorial Boulevard

**From Nashville**, take I-24 East to Exit 78B, and merge onto Old Fort Pkwy / Hwy 96 E toward Murfreesboro. Old Fort Pkwy / 96 E becomes TN-96. Old Fort Pkwy changes name when it crosses US-41 / 70 and becomes Memorial Blvd. Stay STRAIGHT to go to Memorial Blvd / US-231N. It is approximately 6 miles from the interstate to the show location.

**From Lebanon**, take US-231S toward Murfreesboro. As you come into Murfreesboro, US-231S becomes Memorial Blvd. The show location is approximately 1 mile past the Alvin York VA Hospital.
