1. Traditional dealer sponsorship – Some think we should approach Rocky Williams in Lebanon first as his dealership is near the show site. Nashville Dodge was also mentioned by one of the members as showing some interest in sponsoring the show. The dealer in Gallatin was also mentioned as they were at the show with a beautiful Dodge truck.
2. Sponsorship from the Dealer Association – This, in effect, would have the area dealers all sponsoring the show. The problem here is that we are yet to find out who the contact is for the Dealer Association.
3. Charging Spectator Admission – This idea has been talked about in the past and to date has been tabled as it was thought it would hurt our attendance. The suggestion was made we charge one to two dollars admission for adults 16 years and older, under 16 free with an adult.

I am sure we will revisit these ideas soon.

2. Keep **RIGHT** to take **I-70 E** via **EXIT 112A** toward **COLUMBUS OH**. 2.2 miles
3. Take **EXIT 85B** toward **KEYSTONE AVE NORTH**. 0.1 miles
4. Merge onto **N RURAL ST**. <0.1 miles
5. **N RURAL ST** becomes **KEYSTONE WAY** 0.4 miles
6. **KEYSTONE WAY** becomes **N KEYSTONE AVE**. 1.5 miles
7. Turn **LEFT** onto **E. 38TH ST**. 0.8 miles
8. End at **Indiana State Fairground, 1202 E 38TH ST., Indianapolis, IN** **END**
