Congratulations to club members Steve and Louie Yeldell, Bill Cook, and Larry Crawford on celebrating birthdays this month.



Rodger's eye-grabbing E-Body is the result of over 3,000 man-hours of work to bring it into the shape you see here. You can barely see the Top Banana rear

Bumblebee stripe, which Rodger says is factory correct, as is the Go Mango paint on the rest of the body, which was shaved of its side marker lights, mirrors and door handles.

Underneath is a 383 bored and stroked to 489 inches. Behind that is a Tremec five-speed and a Strange S-60 rear end



with a 3.55-geared Eaton TrueTrac differential. Chassis highlights include 13-inch Baer disc brakes at each corner, with 18-inch five-spoke wheels and low profile tires all around.

Inside, there's a custom suede and leather interior that also boasts a custom center console and dash—the latter with a set of Mooneyes gauges keeping their eyes on the stroker's functions.
