OCTOBER MEETING SUMMARY

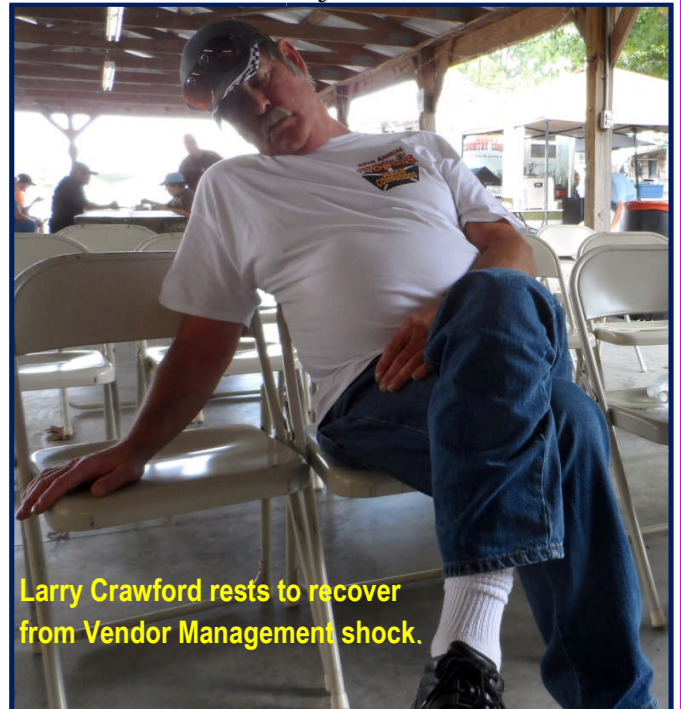

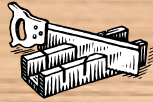
