## BY-LAWS OF THE MUSIC CITY MOPAR CLUB

### ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE

1) THE PURPOSE OF THE MUSIC CITY MOPAR CLUB IS TO BE A TOTALLY NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT IS: "DEDICATED TO THE RESTORATION, PRESERVATION, AND PROMOTION OF CHRYSLER PRODUCTS. "

### ARTICLE 2: MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

- 1) MEMBERSHIP IN THE CLUB SHALL BE OPEN TO OWNERS OF MOPARS AND PERSONS INTERESTED IN ACQUIRING MOPARS. (THIS ACQUISITION MUST TAKE PLACE WITHIN ONE YEAR OF JOINING MCMC.)
- 2) NON-MOPAR OWNERS MEMBERSHIP WILL BE REVIEWED BY CLUB OFFICERS UPON RENEWAL DATE.
- 3) MEMBERS CARS CAN BE IN ANY STAGE OF RESTORATION AND DO NOT HAVE TO BE "SHOW QUALITY".
- 4) MEMBERS MUST SIGN CLUB LIABILITY RELEASE FORM.
- 5) MEMBERSHIP DUES SHALL BE \$15.00 PER YEAR. THIS FEE INCLUDES THE MEMBERS IMMEDIATE FAMILIES WITH FULL CLUB PRIVILEGES. VOTING PRIVILEGES WILL BE EXTENDED TO MEMBERS OF LEGAL DRIVING AGE.
- 6) MEMBERS MUST COMPLETE AN APPLICATION FORM.
- 7) MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AFTER 30 DAYS.
- 8) SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP STATUS SHALL BE FOR:
  - A) NON-PAYMENT OF DUES 30 DAYS AFTER DUE DATE.
  - B) INFRACTION OF ANY CLUB RULE OR ANY OTHER CAUSE VOTED BY A MAJORITY OF THE CLUB MEMBERSHIP. (THE SUSPENDED MEMBER SHALL IMMEDIATELY BE NOTIFIED IN WRITING. THE SUSPENDED MEMBER SHALL THEREAFTER BE ENTITLED TO A REASONABLE OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD, IN PERSON OR THROUGH A REPRESENTATIVE OF HIS CHOICE CONCERNING THE ALLEDGED MISCONDUCT OR INFRACTION. THE DECISION OF THE MEMBERSHIP VOTE SHALL BE FINAL.



ARTICLE 3: GOVERNMENT

*Will be on*

- 1) THE MCMC BY-LAWS WILL BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED AT EVERY JANUARY MEETING.
- 2) THE GOVERNMENT OF THE MCMC WILL BE VESTED IN A PRESIDENT VICE-PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, EVENT DIRECTOR, AND EDITOR/TREASURER. (ELECTIONS WILL BE HELD EVERY JANUARY, WITH VOTING CARRIED BY MAJORITY RULE. TERM OF OFFICE IS ONE YEAR.

ARTICLE 4: MEETINGS

- 1) MONTHLY MEETINGS WILL BE HELD 4<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY AT ~~7:00~~ PM OF EVERY MONTH UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP BY THE OFFICERS.
- 2) A QUORUM OF MCMC SHALL BE THOSE MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING. RESOLUTIONS MAY BE PASSED BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF THE QUORUM. THEREFORE, IT IS HIGHLY IMPORTANT THAT ALL MEMBERS ATTEND THESE MEETINGS SO AS TO BE ABLE TO VOTE ON CLUB MATTERS.

ARTICLE 5: MEMBER CONDUCT

- 1) ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OR USE OF PROFANITY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT ANY MEETINGS OR CLUB EVENTS.
- 2) RECKLESS DRIVING AND BURNOUTS SET A POOR PUBLIC IMAGE AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- 3) IT IS EXPECTED THAT MEMBERS WILL CONDUCT THEMSELVES RESPONSIBLY AT ALL CLUB MEETINGS AND EVENTS.

ARTICLE 6: PERSONAL LIABILITY

ALL PERSONS OR CORPORATIONS EXTENDING CREDIT TO, CONTRACTING WITH, OR HAVING ANY CLAIM AGAINST THE CLUB OR ITS OFFICERS OR MEMBERS SHALL LOOK ONLY TO THE FUNDS AND PROPERTY OF THE CLUB FOR PAYMENT OF ANY DEBT, DAMAGES, JUDGEMENT OR DECREE OF ANY OTHER MONEY THAT MAY OTHERWISE BECOME DUE OR PAYABLE TO THEM FROM THE CLUB OR ITS MEMBERSHIP, SO THAT NEITHER MEMBERS OF THE CLUB NOR THE OFFICERS PRESENT OR FUTURE SHALL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE THEREFORE. EACH MEMBER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR READING AND SIGNING THE RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM SUPPLIED BY THE CLUB.
