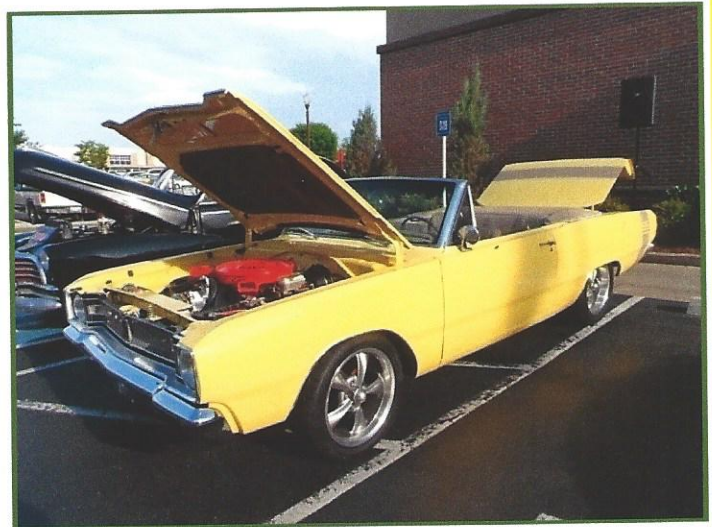

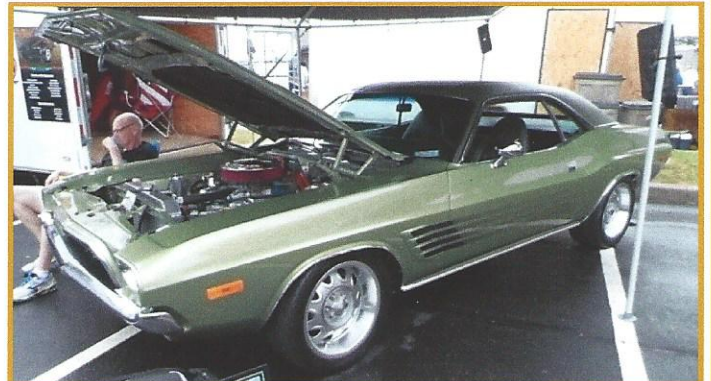

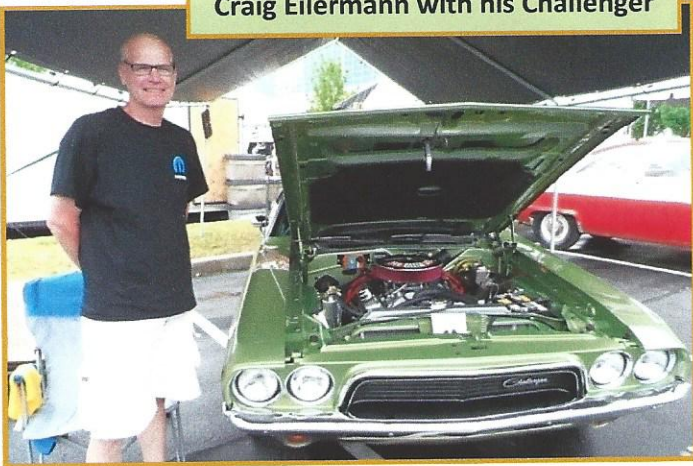

Jim Peach accepted the Appreciation Plaque from Goodguys and Wayne disappeared with the Check.

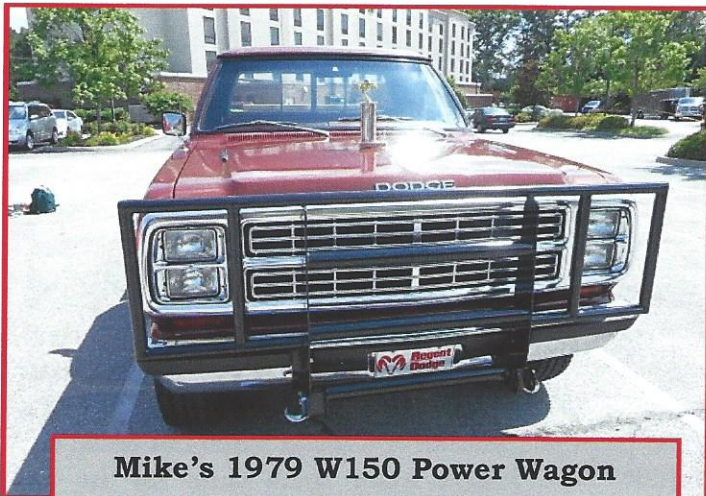
