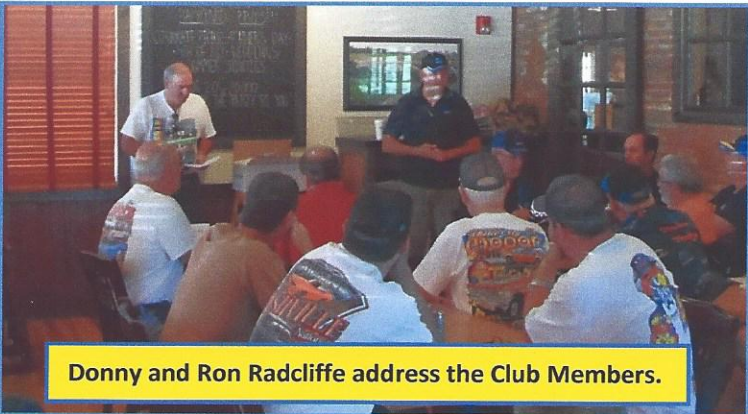

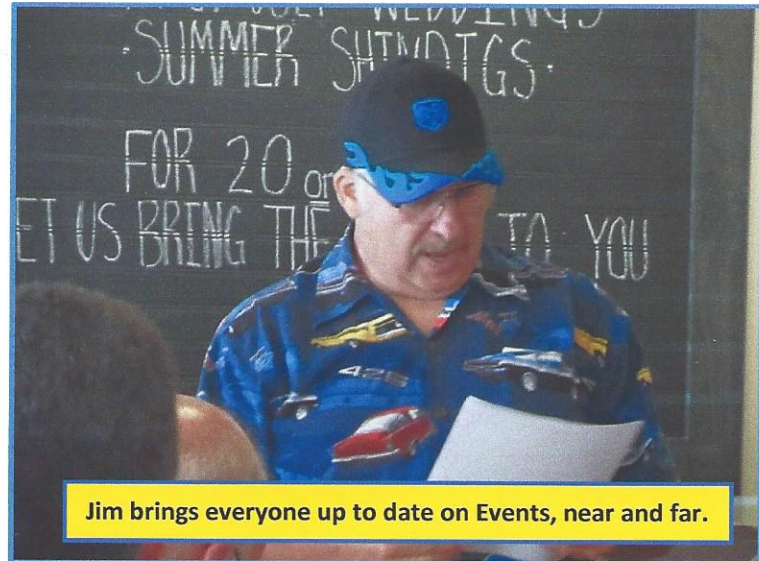

East Tennessee Mopar Club

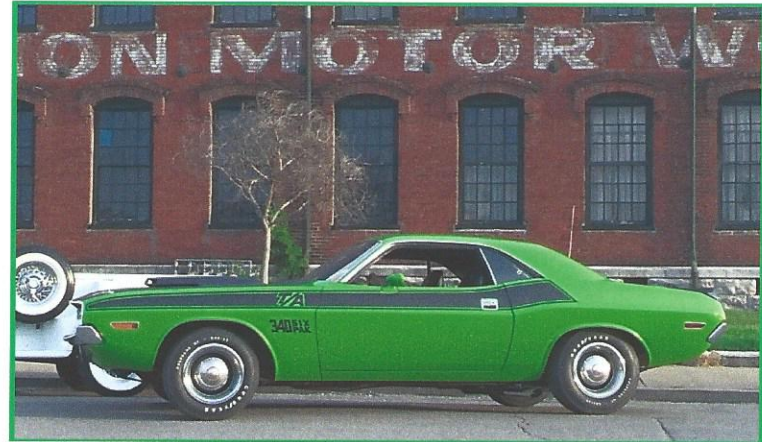

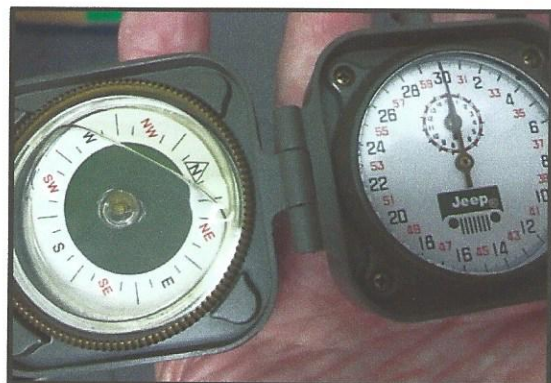

second time in three years as leader of the "Sporty Car" segment.

The survey taps 66,000 owners of 2015 vehicles, using 50 attributes, and giving awards in 12 car and 15 truck/SUV categories. GM, Ford, and Hyundai-Kia had more winning entries than FCA. 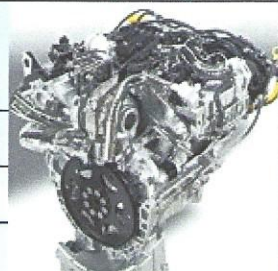
BOSCH STUDY: DIESELS ARE CHEAPER

The University of Michigan released a study showing that modern diesel cars and trucks are cheaper in the long run than gasoline-powered vehicles, despite their higher up-front costs (and the higher price of diesel fuel in most states).

Bruce Belzowski, managing director of the U-M Transportation Research Institute's Automotive Futures group, compared thousands of gasoline and diesel versions of similar vehicles sold at auction in 2012-13, drawing from Audi, BMW, Chevrolet/GMC, Ford, Mercedes, Ram, and Volkswagen cars and pickups.

The total cost of ownership, including depreciation, fuel costs, repairs, maintenance, insurance, fees, and taxes, generally ranges from \$2,000 to \$7,000 less over the three to five year range. There are some exceptions.

Resale values are 30-50% higher for diesel cars and SUVs, and 60-70% higher for diesel medium-duty pickup trucks, after three years; the difference is higher after five years. Diesels in the study drew around 12-27% less fuel for cars and 4-8% less for medium-duty pickups.

Combined costs for insurance, repairs, maintenance, fees, and taxes, were higher for nearly all the diesels.

The report was underwritten by Bosch, covered only 2012-13 models, and used data from Manheim Auctions, Vincentric, Black Book, and the United States



FCA LEADS TWO AUTOPACIFIC SATISFACTION AWARDS

The Jeep® Grand Cherokee was the highest ranking midsize SUV for the fifth consecutive year in AutoPacific's Vehicle Satisfaction Awards. Dodge Challenger also returns for the

BARRACUDA TRADEMARKED AGAIN

While the name "Barracuda" is now used for everything from hard drives to door hardware, it may return to cars, if a trademark by FCA US is any indication.

Before enthusiasts get too excited, be warned that the name has been re-trademarked before, and the use is still unknown, other than "Motor vehicles, namely, passenger automobiles, their structural parts, trim and badges." It may simply be that Mopar is making or licensing Barracuda badges. Or there may be a new Barracuda on the way despite the abandonment of that name some time ago, now that there is a new rear wheel drive platform coming.

The name was filed on June 23, 2015. The original Plymouth Barracuda was a Valiant fastback; in 1970, the name was moved to a body specially designed to use the company's biggest engines, shared with the Dodge Challenger.

Ron Gillespie recently found automotive print advertisements from the "Courier" newspaper, dated August 10, 1972. Here is one of the ads:

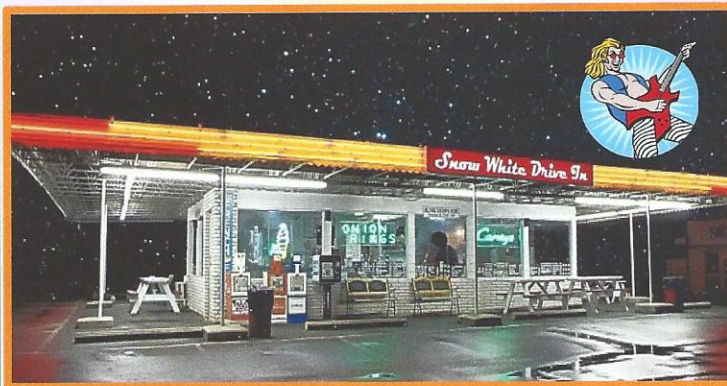
