All proceeds went to the Wounded Warrior Project. Jim was the only member who attended and had a fantastic time. Maybe some other club members will make the trip with him next year.
 - Plymouth Night at the Hendersonville Cruise-In included at least 54 Mopars and a beautifully restored Hemi powered 1934 Plymouth received the "Ride of the Week" award. Mike's recruiting efforts were successful.

 - "A & D Restorations" will have a Rotisserie Display that will include Donny Lippard's car for demonstration.
 - In addition to T-shirts and license plates, Caps {\$15} and Decals {\$10} will be available for purchase in the pavilion.
 - TV raffle tickets and 50/50 tickets will be available in the pavilion and on the show field. Volunteers are needed to help with these items.
 - Donny distributed copies of a map showing the Check-In locations to distribute registration forms, classify entries, collect fees and give directions for those who have pre-registered. Registration will still be completed in the Pavilion.
 - Wayne Hall mentioned that we still need a sponsor for the "Model Car Class".
 - Mike and Wayne need more volunteers to help with judging. You will be able to judge with an experienced judge on vehicles with which you are familiar.

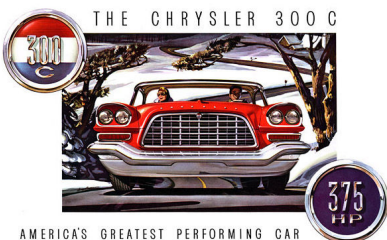

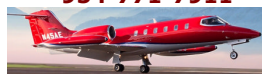
