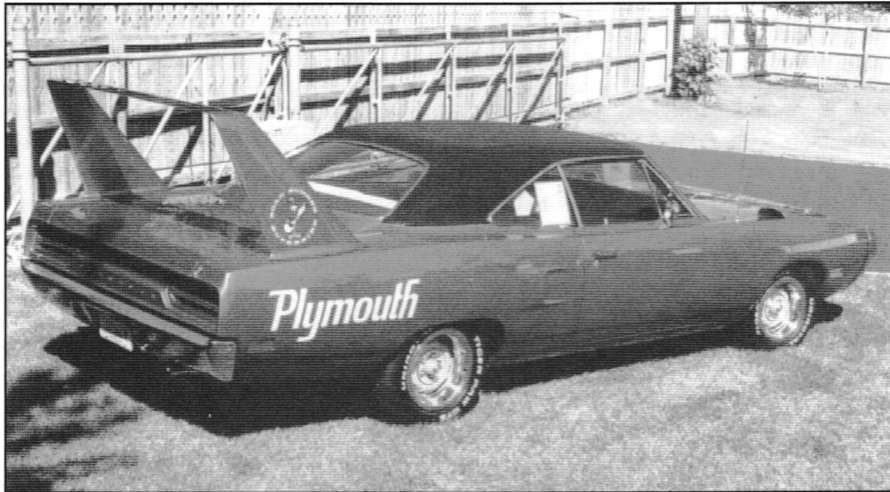

## MEMBER'S MOPAR

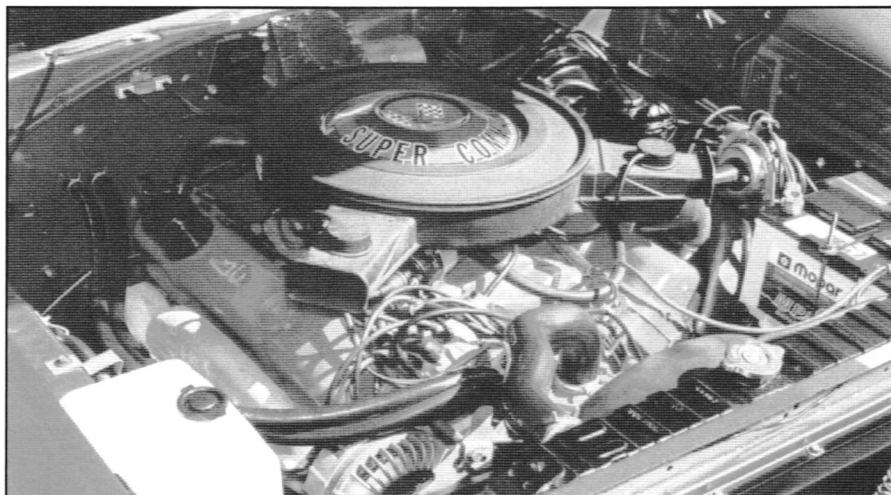
This story starts back in 1974 in Tullahoma, TN when in high school, I worked at a local supermarket. Every Friday afternoon, a regular customer who owned an orange Superbird would come and get their groceries. We would all chuckle at the car, but since I had followed NASCAR even before then, I knew why this cat had been built. Fast forward to 1989. At that time AI had been on the lookout for one of these cars I had laughed at years before. After months of visits and phone calls, I ran into a fellow Mopar enthusiast, Larry Bell, from outside the Indianapolis area. What he had interested me very much, a very low mileage, original Superbird. Here is the story on my Bird.

A man who was 74 years old at the time purchased this car at a Chrysler dealership in New Baltimore, Ohio in July of 1970! His wife, who was 53, was having a lot of back problems at the time, was going to be the primary driver. They went to the lot to pick out their new ride, but she just couldn't find anything in the Imperial or Polara line that was comfortable to her. This Superbird was on the lot. She sat in it, test-drove it, it felt good, and they bought it right there. In 1973, the car had about 13,000 miles on it when the man decided to park it. At that time, he stored the Bird in a shed just big enough to hold it, smeared Vaseline on all the trim and chrome, bought a brand new exhaust system and hung it on the wall, and covered it up with a tarp. In late 1988, this old man, who was 93 then, drove the car back to the original dealership which still operates from the same place, and asked if they wanted to buy it back because his two grandsons were starting to feud over the car and he wasn't even dead yet! A deal was struck and mechanic at the dealership knew Larry Bell and told him to get over there quick. He drove over the next day and purchased the car and brought it back to Indianapolis. What he had was an untouched, original, unmolested, 13,000-mile Superbird. He owned it for six months and in late 1989, I purchased the car from Larry. He never registered the car so I guess technically I'm the second owner. I struggled mentally whether to restore this car or not, It had one small pressure dent in the nose where the old man had bumped the lawn mower into it and several small paint dings down each door. Other than that and a dirty engine, it was a great twenty footer. After a few months, I decided to get the car in #1 shape. The car was full of chalk marks, tags, and other original items left on the car. I took it to Mark Stacey of Stacey's Concourse Restoration in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. Mark and his brother Dan are known nationwide for their award winning Mustang and Shelby restorations. Mark wanted to do my car obviously for the attention these cars get at shows. He took pictures of everything, marks, colors, etc... He took every nut and bolt off, bagged it and sent them off to put the right coating on them. The nose and wing were taken off the car, but he left the doors and fenders on there. It was very unusual, but the factory did an excellent job of putting these on this car so well, Mark said he probably wouldn't be able to get them back on that good! He pulled the engine out and repainted and replaced all the brackets, plastic hangers, etc...that needed it. All things original were left on there. It still had the original spark plug wires, heater hoses, etc... on the car so they were retained. (Continued next page)

The interior, which is very unusual being white (most were black), a bench seat (most were buckets) and being a column shift automatic, the vinyl top, and the trunk area along with the original spare tire that has the chalk marks still on it, are completely untouched. The Bird also had the original rally wheel and dated Goodyear Polyglas F-60's on it until about six months ago when I replaced them with 8" rally wheel and newer tires. Now I can drive it and feel safe about it!! While I obtained most of this story from Larry Bell, I decided to check out as much of this as I could, so in my travels that my job takes me, I had to drive to Detroit, and the town the car came from was right off of I-75, 50 miles from Detroit. I drove into this town not much bigger than Mayberry and ran right into Dukes Auto Sales in New Baltimore, Ohio. I went in and introduced myself and explained what I had bought and from whom. The person I was talking to was the son of the owner of Dukes, who had actually ordered all the cars then when he was 23 years old. He confirmed to me everything Larry had told me about this car and even more. He told me the owner was still alive at 96 years old and I could talk to him if I liked. Well, I did and this man was as sharp as a tack, a little hard of hearing, but very aware of what was going on. He had purchased many high performance Mopars in his life, from them including several old Hemi cars (the early ones). This dealership wasn't much bigger than your local Jiffy Lube place, yet the owner's son told me he bought and sold 3 Superbirds, 2 Hemi Cuda's, and 3 TA Challengers among others from this place!!!

My Bird has been featured in Mopar Collectors Guide and Mopar Muscle Magazine. It also was on TNN's Car and Driver program a couple of years ago as well as TNN's Hot Rod Performance program. At the 1994 Winged Car Reunion in Talladega, it was the only car to score above 95% out of 5 Superbirds and Daytona's who entered in the Platinum Judging. There were only 5 allowed to enter because each car was judged for 3 hours each, by 5 judges that included Galen Govier and Frank Badelson. It earned the Platinum Award that day, the only one!! I've had a lot of enjoyment with this car and I still get a kick out of the 20 something's trying to figure out why I would ruin a good Road Runner with that big wing and nose! They made 1920 of these cars, 1145 with the 440-4 barrel. I plan on keeping her for a while longer.
