When I was 18 I was the proud owner of a 1970 Dodge Charger 500. The Charger was my daily driver to school, work and various other activities. I owned this car for two years. It was not a hemi or even a big block. A 318 ci motor with a 904 trans., AC, PS and power brakes. For some unknown reason, maybe being young and dumb had something to do with it, I traded it in for all things a Cheebie 4x4. How stupid was that? I had joined the Marine Corps at this time and was stationed in Southern California. My mother was driving the cheebie and did not care for it at all. So being wiser than me she traded the truck for a Dodge Colt. I was soon looking for another car. I found and purchased a 1973 Dodge Charger Rallye. I became very frustrated and decided to pursue another one of my favorite Mopars, a 1969 Super Bee. Again I found several of these and it was the same old song and dance, rusty or to expensive. I soon said "forget about it for awhile" maybe a car will come along soon.

I kept my eyes and ears open for and leads. In the summer of 2001 while attending the cruise in at Cool Springs, my wife and I spotted a 1969 Plymouth Barracuda Fastback that was awesome. The smooth classic body lines of the little A-body were enhanced with later model Cuda side stripes. Dart Sport hood scoop, Go-wing and 14" rallye rims on the front and 15" on the rear. F8 dark green metallic paint with black stripes that looked really cool. I talked with the owner and found out it was powered by a .60 over 340, 727 trans, 3:91 sure grip. Originally a 318 with AC, and PS. However discussion revealed that it was not for sale. Disappointed again!!!! A couple of months went by and while surfing the net I went to Ronny Hollands web site and lo and behold there was an ad for a 1969 Barracuda for sale. Could it be the same car? I quickly clicked on the ad with great anticipation. Eureka, it was!!!! After contacting Ronny he put me in contact with Jackie Young the owner. We made arrangements to see and drive the car. Man was I excited with the prospect of finally getting another Mopar muscle car after all this time. My wife and son went me to see to see and drive it. I was in awe of the quality of the this car and the asking price. Needless to say a deal was struck and the Cuda now resides in our garage. Thank you to my beautiful wife for making the purchase possible. That's the tale of the Rumblefish.
