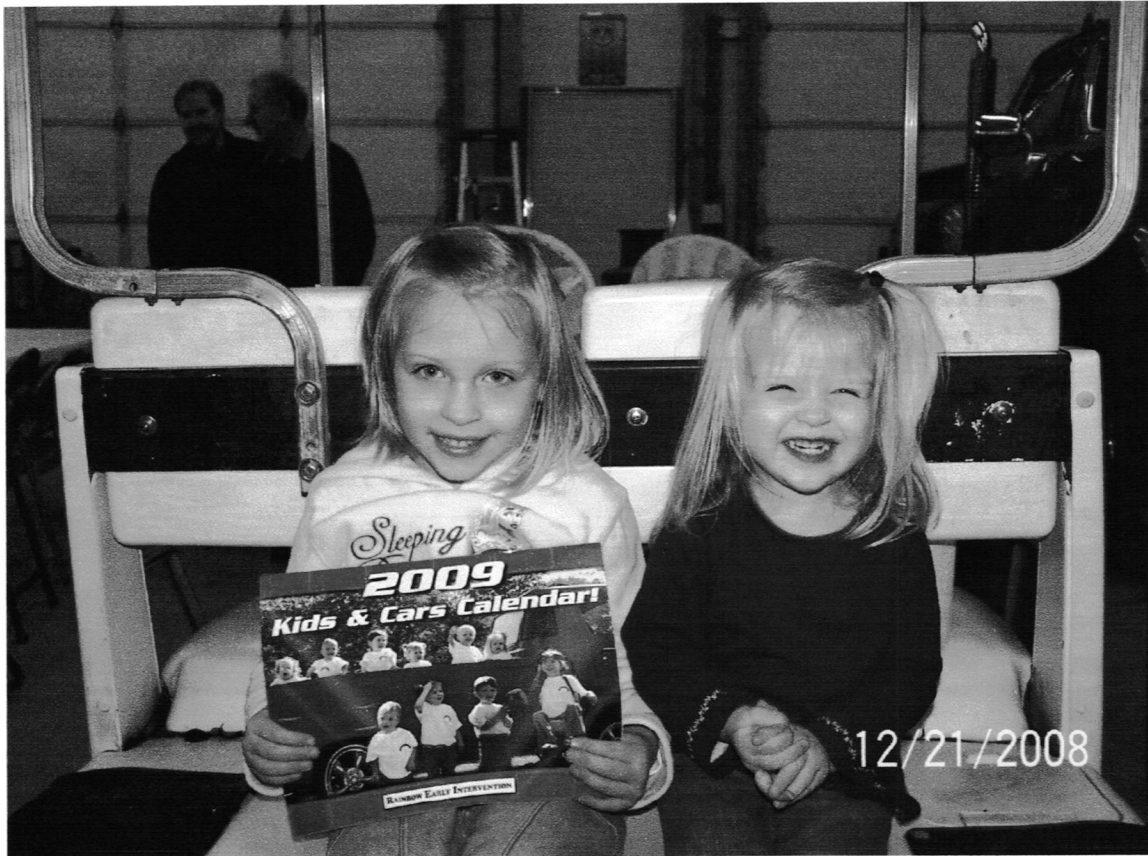
Next, everyone was reminded of the Indy Swap Meet that is the first full weekend in March. We usually have several members who attend and now is the time to get together and try to finalize our plans.
