



We own two Li'l Red Express trucks, are die-hard Mopar enthusiasts and long time members of the Music City Mopar Club.

#### Purpose:

The purpose of this invitation is to encourage your attendance and participation in the 20th annual "All Mopar" Car and Truck Show of the *Music City Mopar Club* in September. The two day event will be the week-end of September 26 and 27 at the James E. Ward Agricultural Center {Wilson County Fairgrounds} in Lebanon, Tennessee. Our show flyer is included in this mailing. #### Flyer Information:

There are 26 show classes listed on the show flyer. For the last 14 years the club had about 34 classes, including a "Lil Red Truck and Warlock" class. Due to low participation the club officers eliminated or combined some of the classes for 2009, one being the "Lil Red Truck and Warlock". In 2008 there were three LRTs at our show, but two of them were mine and they were not judged. If we have at least three entries for LRTs and Warlocks for this year's show, the class will be resurrected. It will be fantastic to have enough entries to have more than one class of LRTs / Warlocks. Time flies, evidenced by the fact it has been 30 years since production of the LRT ended and this year is our club's 20th annual show. If you no longer own one of these trucks, then bring any Mopar that you currently own. If you are interested in selling or purchasing a Mopar, then participate in our "Car Corral".

There will be activities under the roof of the large pavilion that are not listed on the show flyer. Example: We plan to have various videos showing during the day, like historical accounts of Chrysler, Dodge and Jeep, old commercials and training videos from the 60s and 70s, movies at night, and more.

#### **Local Attractions:**

The trip to the Nashville area can include an extended vacation because there are many attractions close to the location of our Car and Truck Show. Some include:

- City of Nashville {about 30 miles from Show Site}: Country Music Hall of Fame, Grand Ole Opry, Ryman Auditorium, Printer's Alley, Tootsie's Orchid Lounge, Wildhorse Saloon, Opryland Hotel, Nashville Zoo, Adventure Science Museum and many more.
- Local Shopping: Prime Outlet of Lebanon, Stones River Mall, Opry Mills, Bass Pro Shops and more.
