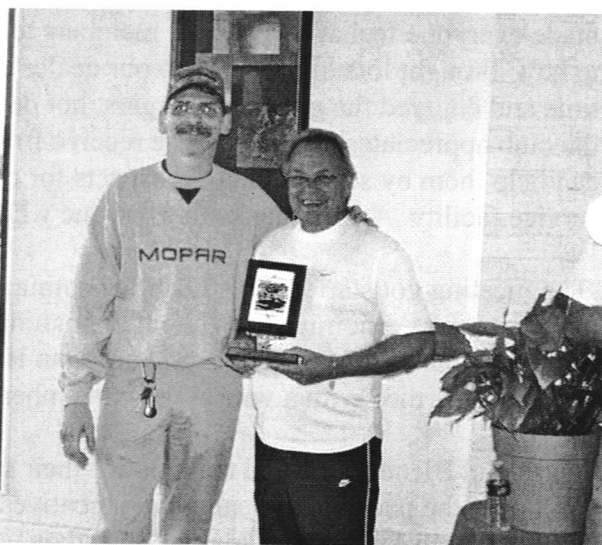

Go about .2 miles, school is on the **RIGHT**. Chucks shop is in the back.
