Keith Petitt, who lost his father in January, took the floor for a moment to thank the club membership for remembering him and his family in our prayers during that difficult time.

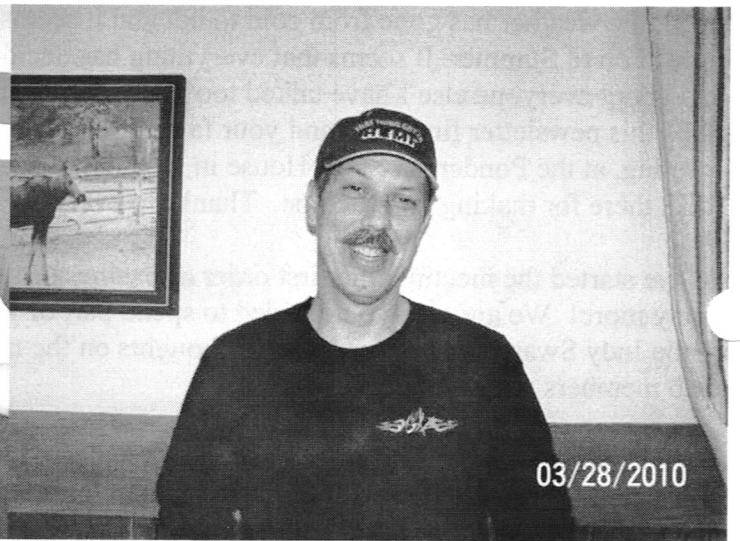

Remember our meeting and Dealer Show at **Frenley CJD** on Sunday April 25.

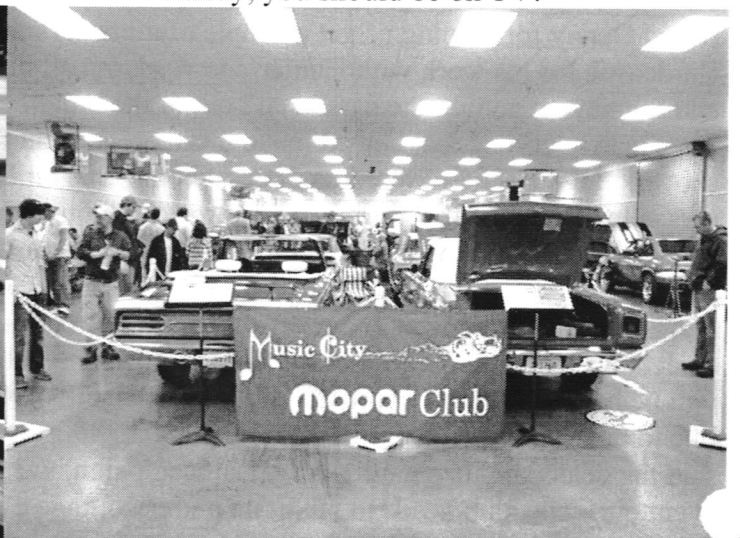
