It was decided that we should continue this discussion at our November meeting and John suggested everyone should bring a list of their ideas for farther discussion at the meeting.

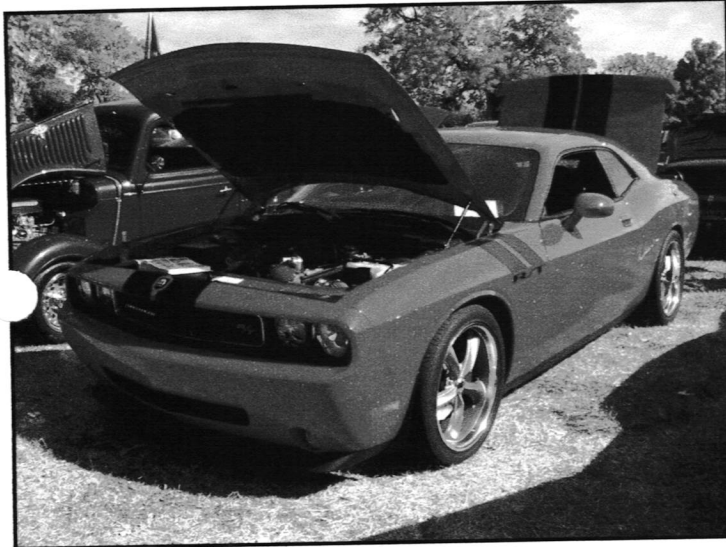

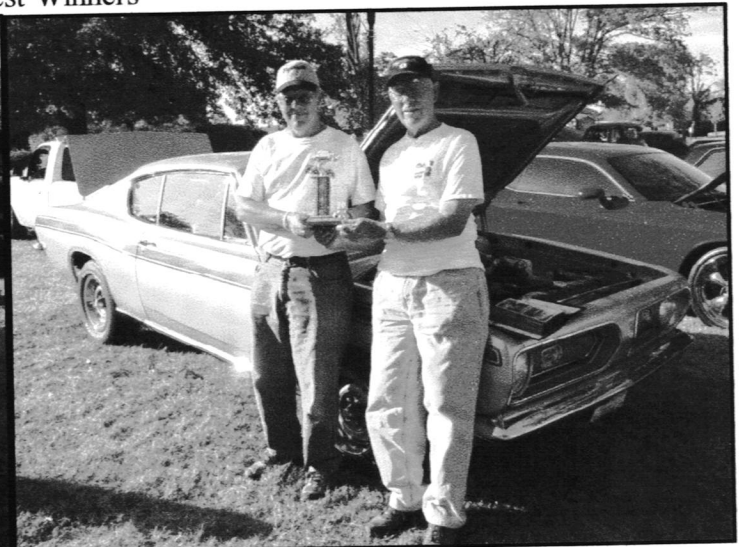
Our condolences go out to Ronny Holland and his family on the death of Ronny's father, Harry E. Holland. Please keep Ronny and his family in your prayers during these trying times

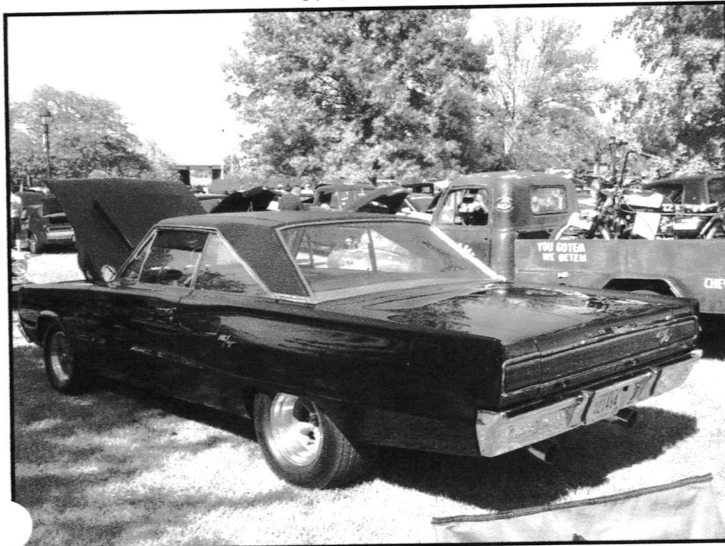
