Exhaust Notes

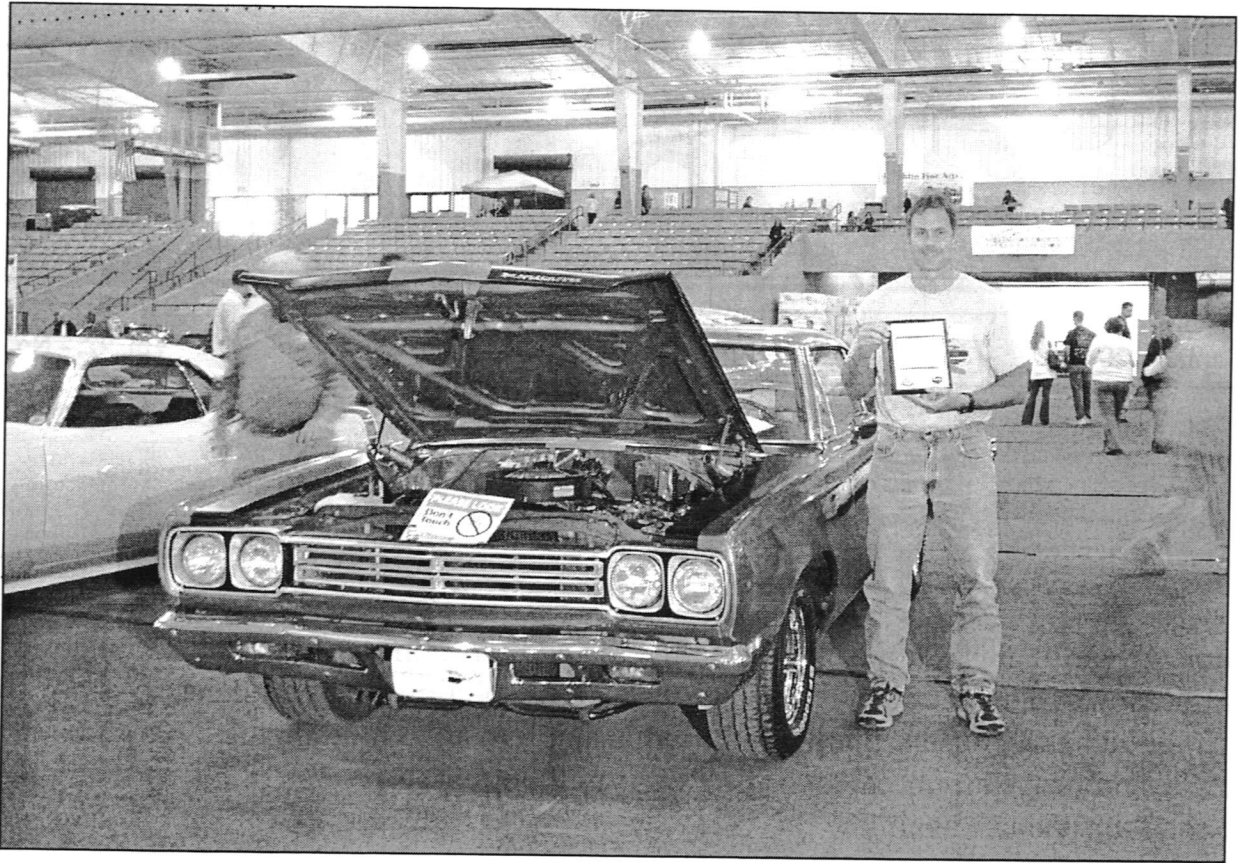

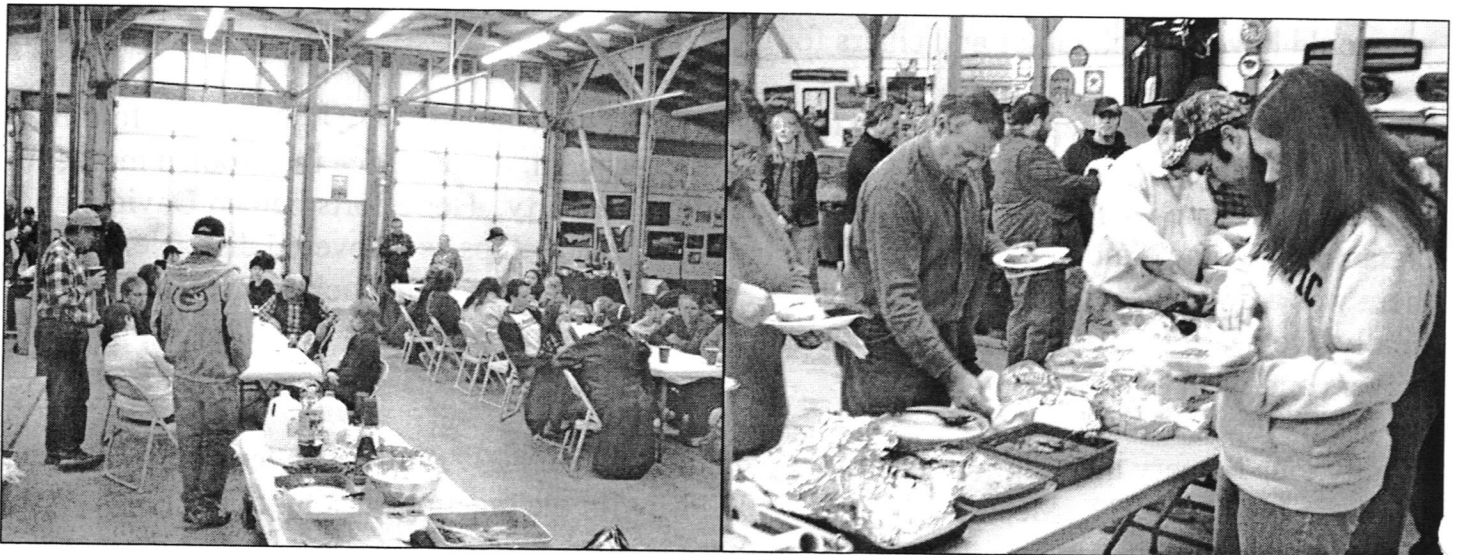
