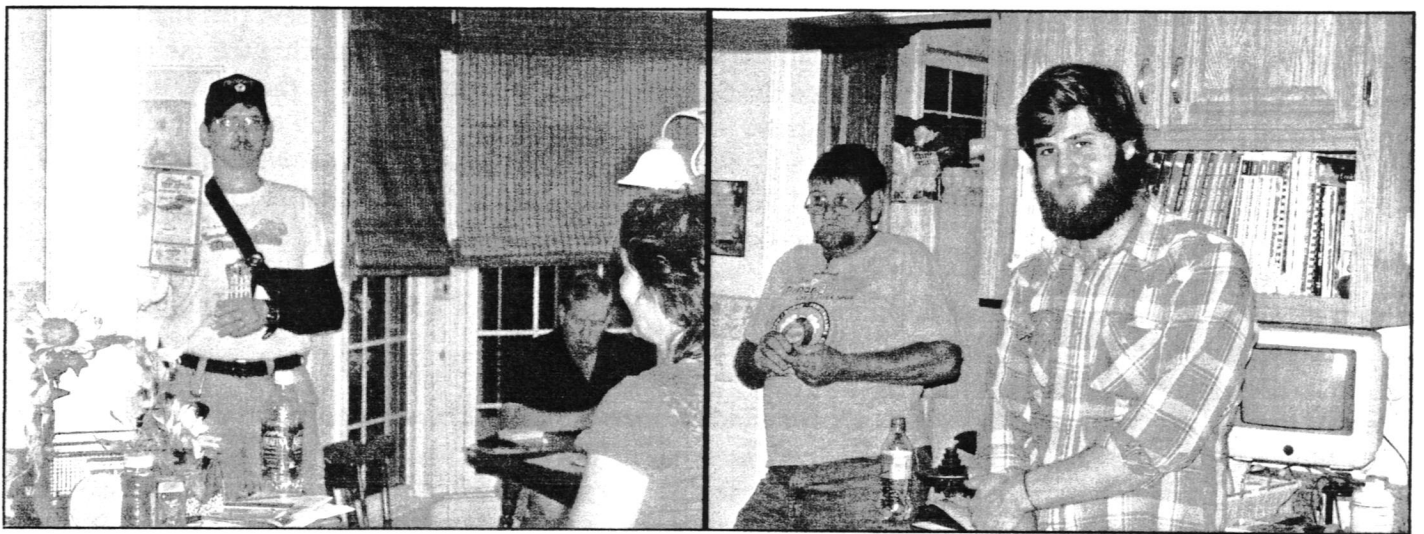
the club and to keep the food vendor line shorter, since some folks complained about having to wait in a long line to buy only a drink. The food vendor will sell drinks also.

"Meet and Greet" will start at 12:00 pm, we plan to eat at 1:00 pm and the meeting will follow at 2:00 pm. We hope to see all of the members there, as we need your input and ideas to help make this year' show a success.
