Vendors will park in the area between the roads next to the pavilion as they have in the past. If they have a car for sale, it will also be in this area. People with only cars for sale will park in the area towards the barns near the open end of the pavilion.

Richard and Linda Price will bring their camper and stay overnight in the area near the cars for sale parking and will also set up the videos of old Mopar commercials that will be showing in the pavilion during the show. A big thanks to Richard and Linda for their commitment to the show.

We will be checking with the Wilson County Fairgrounds officials as to exactly how much space we can use for the show and if there are other events taking place at the same time as our show.

If there is anyone that would be able to help sign people in to the show Saturday morning, please be there around 7 AM. We have early sign in on Friday night, but Saturday morning is always crunch time and any help will make the show run smoother and be more enjoyable for the participants. If they have fun, they will be back next year.

As always, please be on the lookout for items for door prizes, goody bag items, and class sponsors. We will meet at Lester and Pam Bentleys' home to assemble the goody bags for the show on Sunday, September 18th at 2 PM. Please be there if you can.

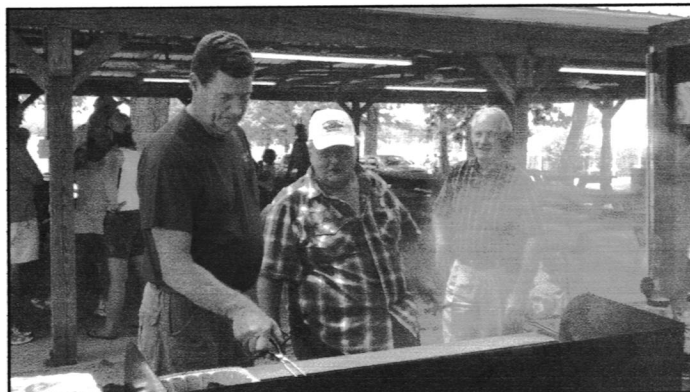

Thanks again for the great turnout for the July meeting. Bring your Mopars to the next meeting to help promote our club and our favorite brand of cars. See you there!

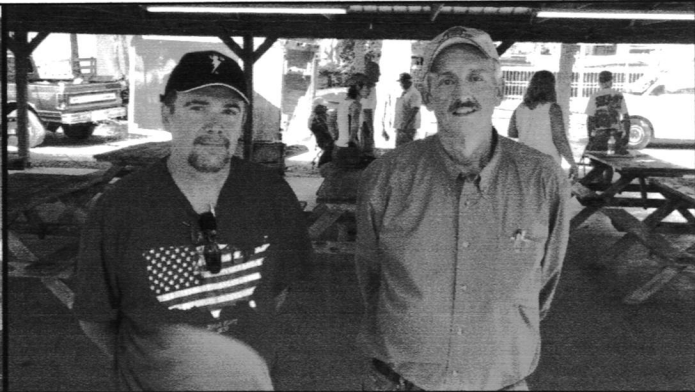
Attention Music City Mopar Club Members

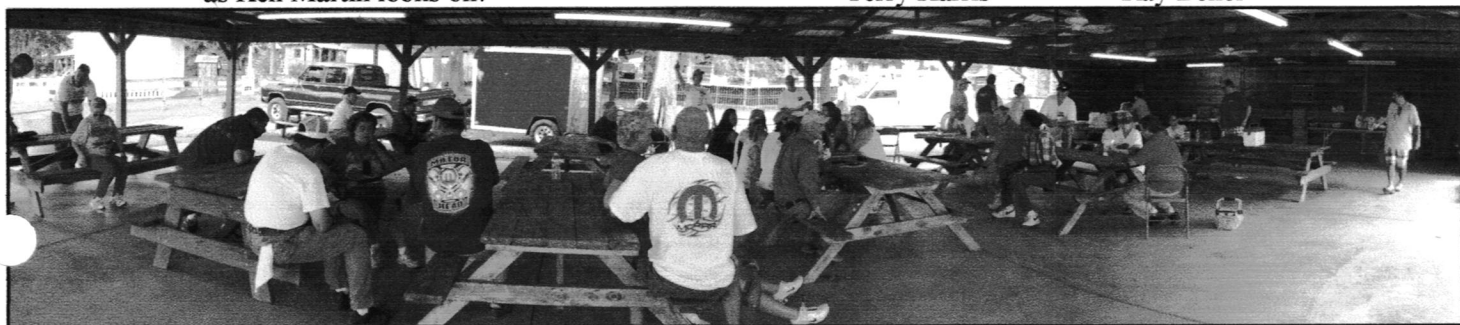
