MARCH 2016 MEETING NOTES:

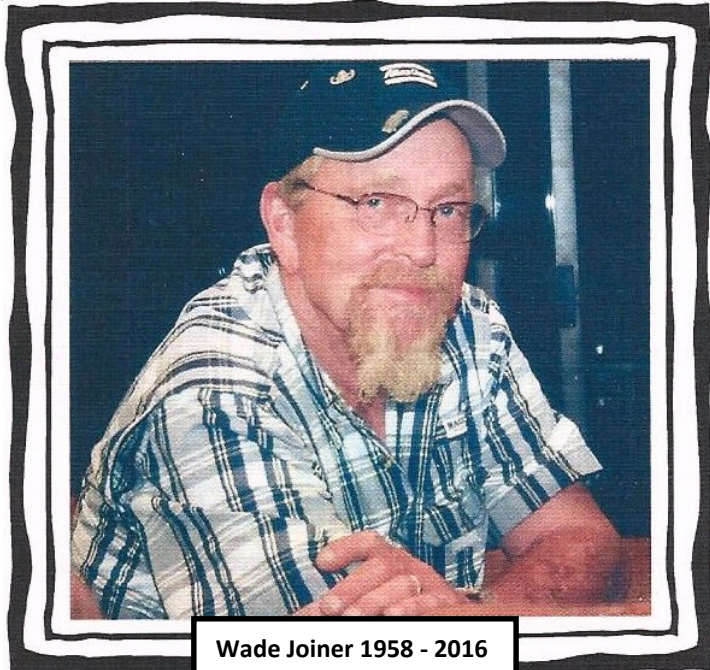

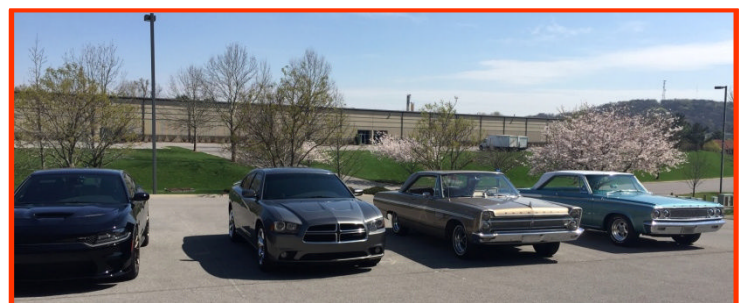
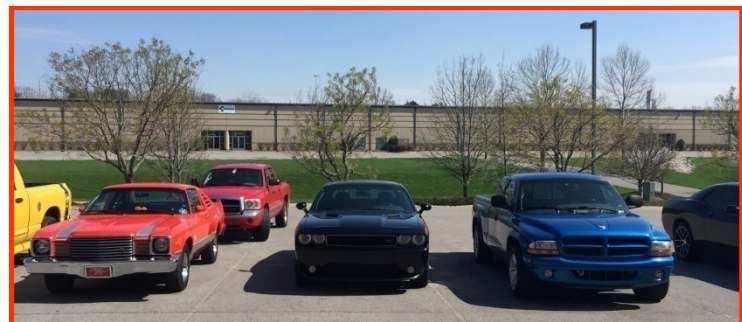
