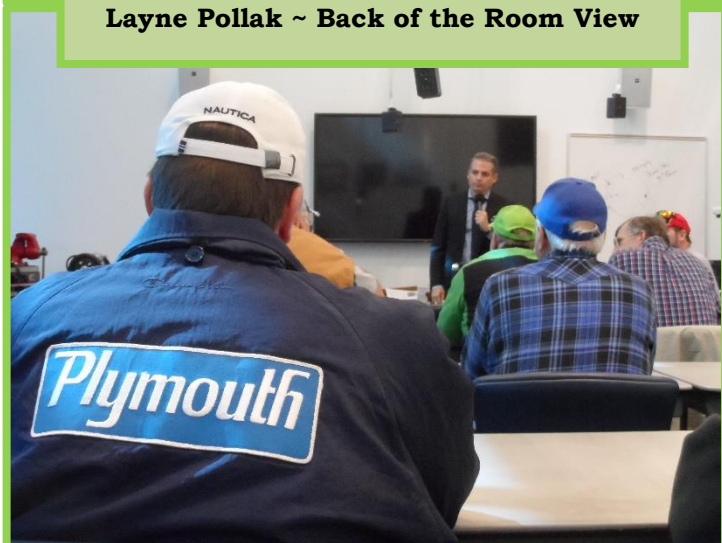

The first order of business was the approval of the minutes of the January meeting. The members voted to continue with the club's current by-laws.
