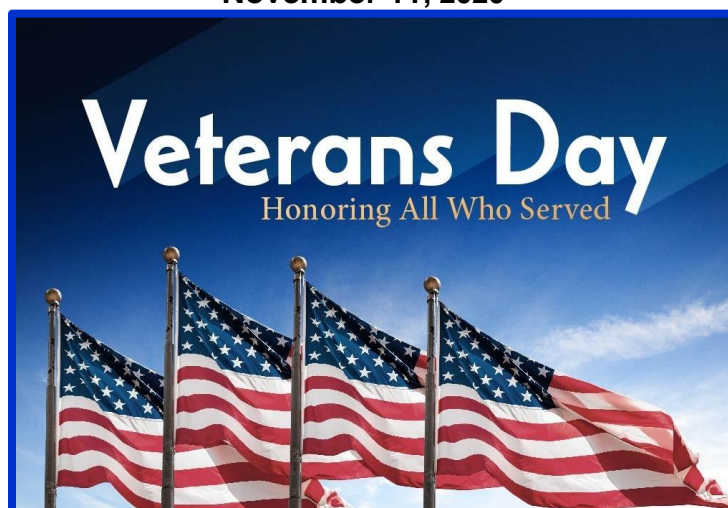
for the Club as well as for everything that they will do in the future as active Club members.

Again, this year we are hosting a Mopar Welcome party on Friday night, November 13 from 6 to 10 PM for \$25 per person including a Big Easy Cajun dinner (plus other food), wine & beer, a live band and dancing. This year we will be giving away \$500 on both Saturday and Sunday (\$100 each hour) based on ticket drawings--tickets are free with your registration. Also, the Park entry road has been paved and we will be parking the first 200 vehicles to enter under the main pavilion. All years of Mopar cars and trucks are welcome, and bring your fire extinguisher for extra score.
