## Meeting notes/Minutes

The February meeting of the Music City Mopar Club was held at the Smyrna location of Jim & Nick's BBQ on Sunday Feb. 27th. The attendance was very good as is normal when there is good food involved.

It was very good to see Club President Mike Wilkins back and feeling better after his recent back surgery. After the members approved the minutes of the January meeting the discussion turned to an update on the club's annual show in





September. Mike and Wayne Hall have met with Gwen and Quenton of the Wilson County Fair Board and the news is very good for the future of the show. The talked about new building that is to be built where the show field was. It has been started. It may not be finished in time for the show this year, but the area will include a lot of paved parking around the building, and we will be able to use the parking areas in the Fiddler's Grove area for the show. When the building is finished, we hope to be able to use it as part of the show. The vendor area will remain as it has been. Spectator parking areas and trailer parking will still be available. There is a new address that we need to start using for the entrance gate near the old store that we have been using for the last couple of years. It is 1033 Sparta Pike. We will include this on the show flyer to give everyone the correct location for use with their gps on their phones and relieve some confusion on how best to get to the show. The best news of all is that we are working on a 3 year deal with an option for a 4th year with the Fair Board. This will be a big help with the future of the show and will lock in a reasonable rate for the use of the grounds.

A new element to our show this year will be the "VIM" area. This will be for "Very Important Mopar", and it will include the show entry fee, a show shirt, a plaque, and inside parking in the barn area. The cost for this will be \$100 and will be limited to 23 spaces. We will continue to have cars displayed in front of the red barn. We have also learned that a building will be built in the area where the New Orleans Mopar Club sets up to cook food for us on Friday night. It remains to be seen how this will change what we do on that end of the pavilion. The host hotel for the show will be the Holiday Inn Express again this year.

The club continues to be in very good financial shape. We have received the check for this year from our Platinum dealer sponsor Freeland CDJR. Please see them for all of your parts and service needs and ask for Jack Jarvis with any questions you may have. The members voted to approve our spending for 2023 which includes a \$500 sponsorship to the Big Easy Mopar Club, \$1000 to Shop with a Cop in Wilson County, \$1500 in scholarship funds to the TCAT school in Smyrna,



\$500 for Toys 4 Tots, and the \$1000 Club Officers' discretionary spending fund to take care of things that may come up during the year. The bylaws of the club were also approved for another year.

The show and cruise-in season is beginning to take off. Upcoming events include the Watertown Open Car Show Mar.26th, Caffeine & Chrome at Gateway Classic Cars Mar.26th, Kars4Kids at the Tennessee Baptist Childrens' Home in Brentwood Apr.16th and Moparfest at the Battleship in Mobile Apr.22nd and 23rd. 
