will get free entry to the show, and you will have a great day with your fellow club members looking at some fabulous rides. For more information on upcoming events, please check our website.

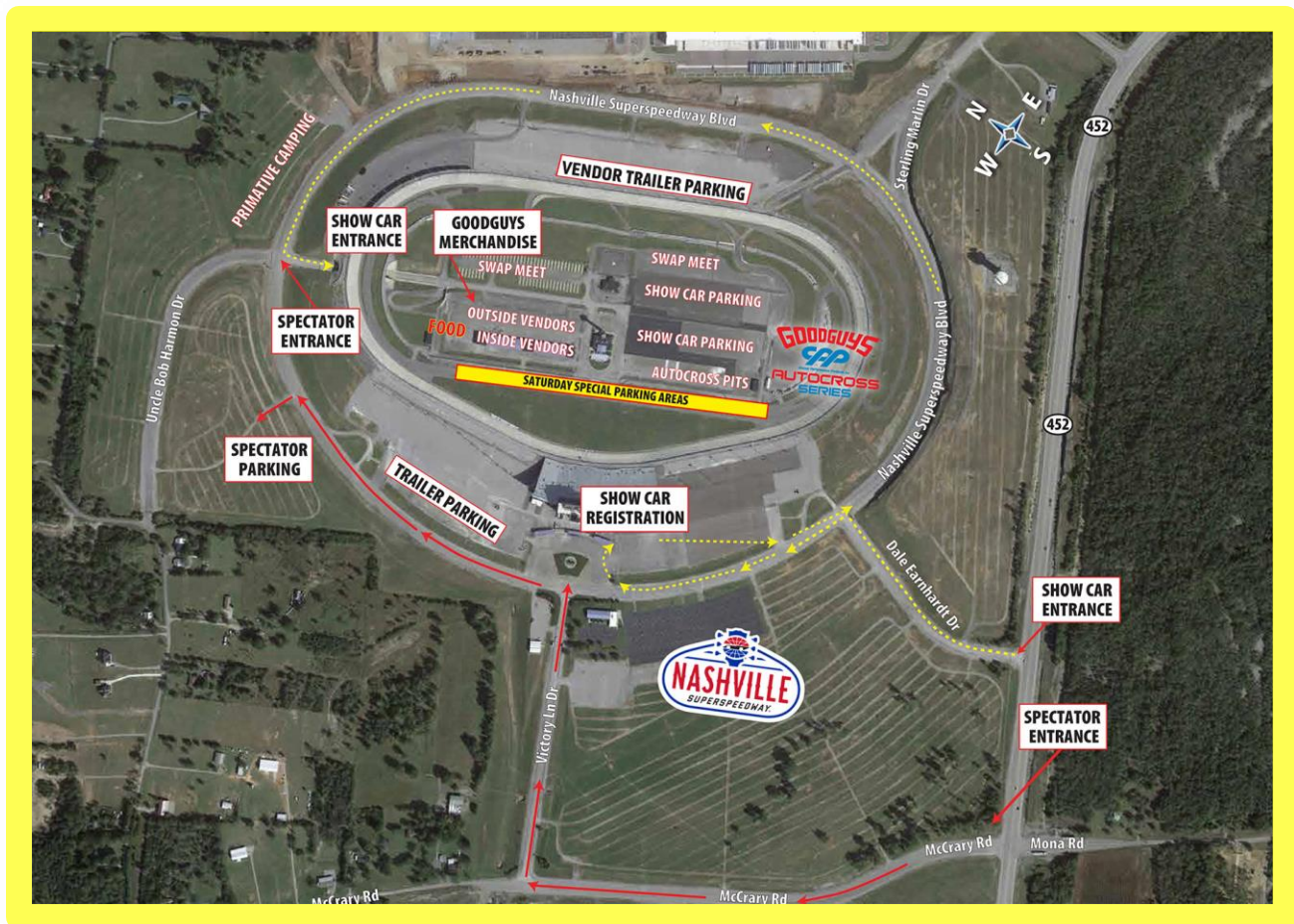

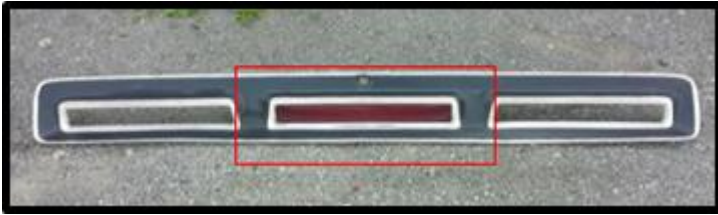
